Starting Monday, October 6th, we will pray a rosary after the daily 7:30 a.m. mass until **Our Lady's** statue departs on Saturday, October 11th.

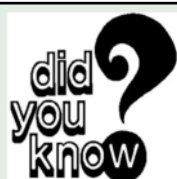

Potential vs. Actual

The sixth grader went to her mother with this homework question: "What's the difference between potential and actual?"

Mom thought for a moment, and then replied, "Go ask your dad, your brother and your sister what they would do if they found a million dollars and no one knew they had it. Would they turn it in or keep it?"

The boy goes first to his older brother with the question.

"Are you kidding? That would pay for college and set me up in business. It's probably drug money anyway. Of course I'd keep it."

The sixth grader writes down his brother's answer and then goes to his sister.

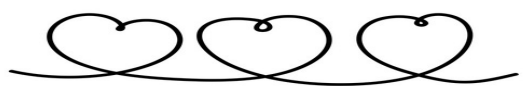
"Of course I'd keep it, silly. It's probably a bribe or payoff that got lost anyway. I'd shop till I dropped and then bank the rest. I'd be set for life."

The student writes down her answer and then goes to talk to Dad.

Dad reasons, "Well, anybody who loses a million bucks can probably afford it. I'd do over the house, put you kids through school, and then have something left for our retirement." The student goes back to Mom and shows her the answers.

"Now do you see the difference between potential and actual?" she explains. "Potentially, we are an honest family, but actually you and I live with three conniving thieves."

In today's Gospel, Jesus chides our tendency to rationalize our self-centeredness, to congratulate ourselves on our "faithfulness" by acting in ways that are the antithesis of that faith. As the sixth grader learns, our "potential" is realized only if we "actually" live the principles and beliefs we confess in our prayers and creeds. Faith begins with the gratitude and humility of the servant in today's Gospel: to realize that we have all been created in the image of a loving God and that the only meaningful return we can make for this life is to love and honor one another as sister and brother "servants" at the table of the Father.
