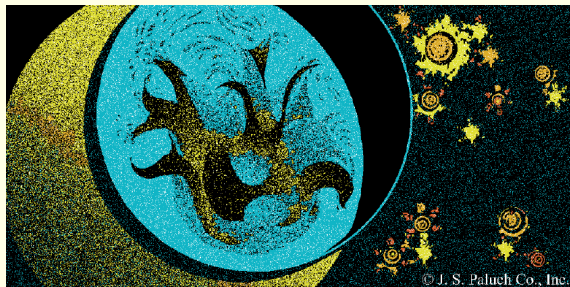
Baptisms: For infant Baptism, contact the Parish Office at least two months in advance.

That's right Thursday nights on Zoom.

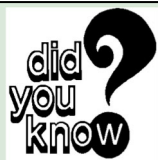

How to help your children with anxiety

We're living in uncertain times, and our anxiety about what is happening today, and will happen in the future, can trickle down to our children, making them anxious, too. This anxiety may manifest in new fears, such that a child becomes reluctant to try new things, or it may exacerbate existing fears, such that a child becomes even more anxious than before. Parents can help their children with anxiety by practicing techniques for deep breathing, ensuring regular exercise and talking honestly about feelings and concerns. 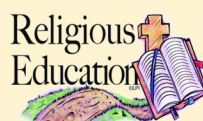

CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC**

(Updated: July 14, 2020)

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

Parish Churches and centers will remain closed until further notice. Church and Religious Education Offices are to be closed to the public. Telephone calls and emails will be replied to accordingly.

Social distancing requires separation of individuals at least six feet apart. Also, practice good hygiene by washing hands with soap and water frequently or using hand sanitizing products with at least 60% alcohol. Any staff who is sick must stay home.

MASS

Archbishop José H. Gomez dispenses all the Catholic Faithful of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and all Catholics currently in the Archdiocese from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass **UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.** The public **celebration of Mass has been suspended** in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles **until further notice. Mass will be livestreamed, Sunday, 9:00 a.m.** The People of God are encouraged to keep the Lord's Day holy by reading the Gospels, praying with your families, and to joining yourself to the sacrifice of the Mass by making an **act of spiritual communion.**
