### Safely store and administer medications for children

During cold and flu season, many parents give their children a fever reducer, cough syrup, and other medications. These medications can help ease your children's symptoms, but if they're administered or stored improperly, they could put your children at risk. Children are far more susceptible than adults to the effects of medication, because their bodies are smaller and still developing. Even small amounts of drugs can be difficult for them to metabolize, so it's critical to follow your doctor's instructions and to closely monitor children who are old enough to administer their own medication. 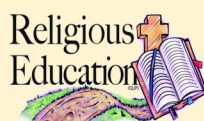

CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC  
(Updated: October 14, 2020)  
GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS**

**Parish churches and centers will remain closed until further notice. Church and Religious Education Offices are to be closed to the public.** Telephone calls and emails will be replied to accordingly.

**Social distancing** requires separation of individuals at least six feet apart. Also, practice good hygiene by washing hands with soap and water frequently or using hand sanitizing products with at least 60% alcohol. Any staff who is sick must stay home.

**MASS**

Archbishop José H. Gomez dispenses all the Catholic Faithful of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and all Catholics currently in the Archdiocese from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass **UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.** The public **celebration of Mass has been suspended** in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles **until further notice. Mass will be livestreamed, Sunday, 9:00 a.m.** The People of God are encouraged to keep the Lord's Day holy by reading the Gospels, praying with your families, and to joining yourself to the sacrifice of the Mass by making an **act of spiritual communion.**
