ELEMENTARY SCHOOL NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY 2020-2021 SCHOOL STUDENT NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

Words can be a warning sign of abuse

Many children will be learning in their own homes this fall, but that does not mean they will be fully protected from abuse. Sadly, most children are abused by someone considered to be a “known and trusted” person – that person may be a family member – even someone living in the same house as the child. Pay attention to the conversations your children are having, as words can be indicators that a child is being groomed or harmed. If your child or their friend(s) seem to “know” more about sexual topics than would be expected for their age, or seems unusually focused on such topics, it could be an indicator that something inappropriate and harmful is happening. Men's Group

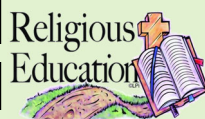

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

Parish churches and centers will remain **closed until further notice. Church Offices are to be closed to the public.** Telephone calls and emails will be replied to accordingly.

Social distancing requires separation of individuals at least six feet apart. Also, practice good hygiene by washing hands with soap and water frequently or using hand sanitizing products with at least 60% alcohol.

Any staff who is sick must stay home.
