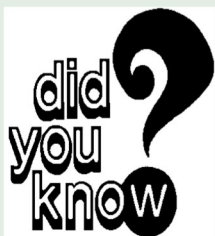

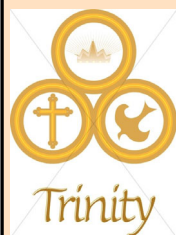

### Respecting Boundaries

### Reflections on the Trinity

The Holy Trinity represents the perfection of love and relational communion:

- The **Father** creates and loves.
- The **Son** redeems and reveals God's mercy
- The **Holy Spirit** sustains and guides believers in ongoing life and holiness.

The number three frequently appears in the life of Christ and scripture, symbolizing completeness, such as the **Holy Family** (Jesus, Mary, Joseph), the **three wise men**, the **temptations of Jesus**, Peter's three denials, and the three days in the tomb before the resurrection. This triadic pattern reflects the **unity and perfection of God's plan** and invites believers to model their lives on divine love--being creative like the Father, compassionate like the Son, and generous like the Holy Spirit.

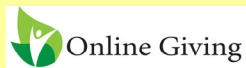

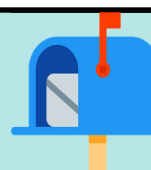

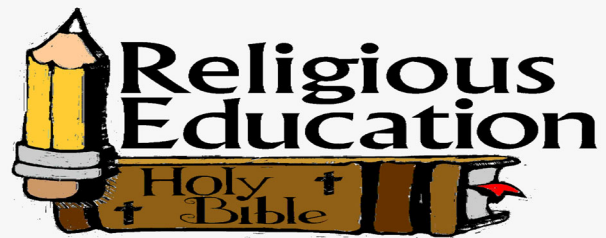

## *"The Fingerprint of God"*

He's the first in his family to go to college. His mom and dad have sacrificed mightily to make his dream possible for him. He's worked hard too, taking on two part-time jobs to help cover the expenses his scholarships and grants don't cover. But Tuesday afternoons are sacred— that's when he spends his afternoon at a city high school mentoring students just like him: students of color who have potential to be the first in their families to go to college. His generosity is the fingerprint of God.

Everyday they rise before dawn and gather in the small room they have made their chapel. They are a community of five religious sisters: two sisters are from the United States who have spent more than 40 years working in Ghana; the three others are native Ghanaian sisters. After Morning Prayer and a simple breakfast, the sisters go to work in their clinic, the community garden they tend with some of the women of the village, and the small pre-school they run for the children of the village. The villagers— many of whom are not Christian — love the sisters not only for their work but for their simplicity and generosity of their life among them — simplicity and charity that are the fingerprints of God.

They have three children of their own and, like all families, making the household budget work each month is a challenge. But they don't hesitate for a moment to make a place their home — and hearts— for a child in need of a safe and welcoming place for a few weeks or months or longer. Over the past 10 years, they have been foster parents to five children. Their own children have happily been big brothers and sisters to these children whose young lives have been a nightmare. Yes, it's demanding and often heart-breaking, but they believe that every child deserves to be loved and cared for. Such compassion is the fingerprint of God.

**In his book *Abide in Love*, Latin American priest and poet, Ernesto Cardeal, writes of "the fingerprint of God" that is found on the molecule of creation, on every moment of inspiration, on every work of peace. Faith begins with realizing the Spirit of God breathing life into all that exists; faith that compels us to continue the creative work of God, faith that invites us to embrace and be embraced in God's love that envelopes every wonder of nature and every manifestation of compassion. Today's Feast of the Holy Trinity invites to realize the many ways and the many people in which the love of God is revealed in our lives. May our own hearts be opened to the Spirit of God revealing the "fingerprint" of God's love in whatever ways we are capable of offering, however small and ordinary and unassuming.**
